We are holding auditions for the lead roles in Arctic Wolf Ice Center's Spring Show.

Skaters Freeskate 1 and up are eligible to try out for a solo role. All ages are welcome! Many lead roles will take place while other skaters are on the ice (ex: groups, or other lead roles in their musical).

Results will be posted on the figure skating board in the lobby on Saturday, February 27 at 12:00pm.

All skaters who receive a lead role will be given the song they will skate to.

It is the skater's responsibility to work with their coach to choreograph the routine.

Since there may be interaction between lead parts and group numbers, or among different roles, soloists may need to attend some of the corresponding group practices, or be prepared to coordinate practices with duet/trio partners.

All lead roles, solos/duets/trios, will need to coordinate with the Jennifer Schoennagel before March 1st to determine costumes.

Costumes can cost between \$60.00 - \$100.00.

Not all skaters auditioning are guaranteed a part. The audition fee is non-refundable.



Audition procedures:

1. Register to audition in Pro Shop.
2. Pick up audition CD on February 13th. The CD will have 3-4 songs that will be different types of music from the musicals in the show. The songs on the CD will not be in the show.
3. Skaters can plan anything they want to do to the music. For example, skating moves, acting, props, etc.
4. Because we want to see each skater's individual creativity, we request that they do not ask a coach to choreograph a tryout routine for them.
5. At tryouts, each skater will perform to all of the songs. Depending on the number of skaters, there may be several skaters on the ice at the same time.
6. To allow skaters time to rest between songs, after a warm up, all skaters take turns skating to song 1, then all skaters will do song 2, etc.
